The World War 2 experience allows your students to live a day in the life of an evacuee or refugee in 1940s England.

Our World War 2 experience is taking place in church venues with wartime history in your local area. Church halls were traditionally used as holding accommodation for child refugees and evacuees whilst finding host families, which makes the day authentically site-specific.

The workshops are led by professional actors, who remain in character throughout the day, constantly incorporating elements of drama and fun to enhance the learning environment. This is a real-life adventure where the children will be immersed in the spirit of the 1940's, experiencing stories, propaganda and historical facts delivered through carefully designed theatre, original war-time audio extracts and wartime music.

The workshop runs for four hours, 10am - 2pm
